# Final Application Due April 1, 2018:

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- **April 1, 2018** – Complete on-line Energy to Care Application found on the *Energy to Care Website/Challenges*

- Participating Chapters submit **FINAL energy data** through Portfolio Manager by completing Data Request form found on *Energy to Care Website/Challenges*

*Sign-ups for 2017 participation have closed. Sign-ups for the 2018 will begin on June 1, 2018. For more information on the 2018 Challenge see below.*

- To complete your 2017 Challenge application, please submit the following two steps:

COMPLETE YOUR FINAL APPLICATION

- **Prior to the submission deadline**, request the facilities participating on your chapter challenge team complete a final data release. Data release templates are automatically populated by Energy Star's Portfolio Manager and can be generated quickly. Hospitals will automatically receive an email acknowledging your data has been received.

# Energy to Care AWARDS

- ASHE Energy to Care Awards applications due April 1, 2018
- ASHE Energy Champion Awards application due April 1, 2018



#### Energy to Care Award

Applications are due April 1, 2018!

The Energy to Care Awards honor health care facilities that reduce energy consumption by 10 percent in a single year or by 15 percent over two years. The program also recognizes previous year award winners that reduce energy consumption by 5 percent.

The energy use reduction percentage is calculated by comparing energy use in the baseline year to the performance year. Energy use is defined as weather normalized source EUI in units of kBtus/sf/yr. This data can be found by pulling a report from your Energy Star Portfolio Manager account. The award requires that an ASHE member conduct a peer review on the application and data submitted. Please ask the ASHE member to verify the peer review is complete by emailing [energytocare@aha.org](mailto:energytocare@aha.org) and providing property name, verification date, and member name and membership number.

#### Energy Champion Award

Applications are due April 1, 2018!

The Energy Champion Award is given out once per year to honor a single facility (acute care hospital or medical office building as defined by Energy Star) that has demonstrated outstanding leadership in energy efficiency. Hospitals and medical office buildings participating in Energy to Care that have an ASHE member on staff are eligible for this prestigious award. The award requires that a Professional Engineer (PE) peer review the application and data submitted. Please ask the Professional Engineer to verify the peer review is complete by emailing [energytocare@aha.org](mailto:energytocare@aha.org) and providing property name, verification date, and Professional Engineer name.

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# Energy Treasure Hunts Completed

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- CICHE - OSF Healthcare – Holy Family Medical Center Energy Star Treasure Hunt Identified \$89,500/year in potential savings going back into patient care
- CICHE - OSF Healthcare – Saint Joseph Medical Center Energy Star Treasure Hunt identified \$206,872/year in potential savings going back into patient care
- NCHEA - Carolinas Healthcare System Stanly identified 233 energy efficiency saving opportunities

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# Participate in the 2018 Energy Treasure Hunt!

ASHE along with the US EPA Energy Star are conducting a post annual conference training that will provide hands-on experience in identifying energy savings in hospitals. The Energy Treasure Hunt is a 1-1/2 day event designed to engage members in identifying low-cost energy savings opportunities from behavioral, operational, and maintenance actions. 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- ***Where is the event?***
  - The Energy Treasure Hunt will take place immediately following ASHE's Annual Conference in Seattle. A local hospital will host the event.
- ***When is the event?***
  - The Energy Treasure Hunt Post Conference training takes place immediately following ASHE's Annual Conference. Participants will be asked to participate in three 1 hour training webinars in the weeks prior to the event. The tentative schedule follows:

  - July 18, 2018
    - 12:30 Bus will pick up participants at the Washington State Convention Center
    - 12:45 Lunch and Event Kickoff – review treasure hunt philosophies, process and calculation details
    - 1:45 to 4:30 teams look for savings opportunities on site and calculate savings
    - 4:45 Bus will pick up participants and transport back to Conference Hotel
  - July 19, 2018
    - 7:15 am: Bus will pick up participants at the Washington State Convention Center
    - 7:30 to 11:30 teams look for savings opportunities on site and calculate savings
    - 11:30 – 12:30 working lunch on site, teams create final presentation demonstrating identified savings
    - 12:30 to 1:30 teams identify and present results – event close-out
    - 1:45 Bus will pick up participants and transport back to Conference Hotel participant departure
